

Regular Council Meeting of November 3, 2015

Present were: Mayor Spieth, Councilmembers Koepke, Naillon, Neal, Hart and Roley.
Absent: None.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Mayor Spieth. Pledge of Allegiance given.
Copies of the October 20th council meeting minutes were read and approved.
Copies of the October 27th budget workshop meeting minutes were read and approved.

Public hearing on the 2016 property tax revenues City Levy Ordinance #846. Review of ordinance. Motion by Neal to adopt ordinance #846, second by Koepke; motion carried.

Public hearing on the 2016 property tax revenues EMS Levy Ordinance #847. Review of ordinance. Motion by Koepke to adopt ordinance #847, second by Roley; motion carried.

Notice received from the Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board regarding renewal applications for Frontier Foods and Quik Mart; no comments.

Board member appointment request received from the Oroville Housing Authority for Mayor Spieth to appoint Santos Gutierrez. Gutierrez appointed by Mayor Spieth, council agreed with appointment.

Chief Hill stated that he has been researching cell phone plans and would like approval to switch the Police Department's service to Verizon Wireless; council approved request.

Councilmember Roley requested that City Hall get a drop box for election ballots; more information would be needed regarding delivery of the ballots to the County, as the City would not want to be responsible for delivery of the ballots to the County.

Gary DeVon commented on the high turn-out for the Business Halloween Trick-or-Treating on Friday, October 30th.
