Wednesday, March 5, 2014

Meeting called to order at 4:38 pm by Chairman Judy Dunston.

Present: Commissioners Judy Dunston, Marc Egerton, Luis Perez and Suzi Seger.  
Staff present: Chris Branch and JoAnn Denney.

Approval of the minutes from the February 19<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. Motion by Suzi Seger to approve the minutes as written, second by Luis Perez; motion carried.

Public comment period / Planning Commission inquiries / Staff updates.

Discussion on the Run to the Border motorcycle event in conjunction with a Blues Festival at Deep Bay Park on May 17<sup>th</sup>. Details still need to be worked out; preliminary approval given by City Council.

Brief marijuana discussion regarding regulations.

Discussion on the Ice Fishing Festival held in Molson; once again there were no fish caught. Event will be moved up next year.

Discussion on the Eisen port-a-potties, etc. located at the Old Chevron property; discussion on enforcement.

Question on status of the Rancho Grande restaurant; Chris stated that the owner has opened a restaurant in Chelan and hasn't had the opportunity to ask him the status of the Oroville restaurant.

Marc would like to see Chris or Christian help point out locations more appropriate for the Eisen's equipment.

Shoreline Master Program map discussion. Chris discussed the Shoreline Recreational designation at the Veranda Beach property and BK Orchard property. Chris felt that the Commission should determine if it is too much; something to think about for future meeting. Discussion on walking trails.

Carbon Cycle Crush status; Chris stated that they have bought the building and they are currently running 24/5 with 8 employees.

Potential member discussion; Chris will be approaching an individual who has expressed an interest.

Shoreline Master Program update. Commission has received hard copies of Chapters 1, 2 and 8. Need to review and start public participation. Public Participation will be Chapter 3. Need to review Chapters 1 and 2 prior to the next meeting. Discussion on the County's SMP update status. Water quality discussion. Explanation on factors involved in determining the Ordinary High Water Mark.
