The meeting was called to order at 4:40 by Chairman Luis Perez.

Approval of the minutes from the June 17th meeting. Motion by Suzi Seger, second by Arnie Marchand, motion carried.

Discussion opened regarding the "Animal" ordinance. Chris explained that dogs were not addressed in this ordinance because there is a separate ordinance specific to dogs, one specific to dangerous dogs, and one for cats.

Arnie Marchand made a motion to present this ordinance to the City Council, Suzie Seger seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The Comprehensive Plan was the next topic of discussion.
